


- If the video clips are playing too softly, check that the volume bar on the Kahoot! platform is at maximum volume.

1 30 sec		<p>Say: "Today we're going to take you behind the scenes at Amazon to learn how people and computer science work together to bring you your favorite TV shows and movies."</p> <p>Optional: Ask a few students about what jobs they know about in filmmaking. Tell students that today they'll learn about new careers that also work with TV shows and movies every day.</p>	
2 30 sec		<p>Set tour expectations with your class.</p> <p>Read the expectations to students.</p> <p>Say: "As we go through the tour, you will learn new vocabulary words and information. Be sure to take notes on your notecatcher! There will be a mix of polls and quiz questions. Polls won't count towards your points. Remember the fastest CORRECT answers get the most points. Let's see who will win today!"</p>





4 45 sec		<p>Read the quiz question and answer choices to students: Students answer the question. Acknowledge the answers.</p> <p>Correct Answer: All of the answer choices are correct.</p>	
5 5 min		<p>Play Video 2: Step 1 (5:02)</p> <p>Then Say: "Next up is another quiz question. We'll review what we learned in the previsualization stop. Remember, speed and correct answers get you more points!"</p>	
6 45 sec		<p>Read the quiz question and answer choices to students: Students answer the question. Acknowledge the answers.</p> <p>Correct Answer: Make the audience feel an emotion, like happy or sad.</p>	

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7 7 min 30 sec		<p>Play Video 3: Stop 2 (7:29)</p> <p>NOTE: This video contains 2 career interviews. If strapped for time, skip the second interview by clicking “Next”, “Go On”, or “Skip” in the top right corner when the video gets to that part.</p> <p>Say: “We have 2 trivia questions now that test your knowledge of virtual production! Let’s see what you’ve learned.”</p>	
8 30 sec		<p>Read the quiz question and answer choices to students: Students answer the question. Acknowledge the answers.</p> <p>Correct Answer: hardware / software</p>	
9 45 sec		<p>Read the quiz question and answer choices to students: Students answer the question. Acknowledge the answers.</p> <p>Correct Answer: It is the software used to build and run interactive 3D virtual model sets.</p>	





(2:58)</p>	<p>Play Video 4: Stop 3 (2:59)</p> <p>Say: "Time to answer a question about timecode! Show what you learned about how math is used in post-production of TV shows and movies!"</p>	
11 45 sec	 <p>What happens if an editor's timecode math is off by just a tiny fraction of a second?</p> <p>44</p> <p>0 answers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The actor's lips won't match the words you hear. The editors can overlook such errors. Nothing at all - being off by a few frames doesn't affect the final movie. The movie will play in reverse. 	<p>Read the quiz question and answer choices to students: Students answer the question.
